
Naaman's Seven Dippings

MOST SCRIPTURE PASSAGES ARE QUOTED FROM THE AUTHORISED KING JAMES VERSION (KJV)


oday we shall study a passage of scripture in the OLD TESTAMENT and try to understand its SPIRITUAL SIGNIFICANCE for us .

Yes! Let us now turn to the passage in -

2 Kings 5:1-14

Now Naaman, captain of the host of the king of Syria, was a great man with his master, and honourable, because by him the Lord had given deliverance unto Syria: he was also a mighty man in valour, but he was a leper. And the Syrians had gone out by companies, and had brought away captive out of the land of Israel a little maid; and she waited on Naaman's wife. And she said unto her mistress, would God my lord were with the prophet that is in Samaria! For he would recover him of his leprosy. And one went in, and told his lord, saying, thus and thus said the maid that is of the land of Israel. And the king of Syria

said, Go to, go and I will send a letter unto the king of Israel. And he departed and took with him ten talents of silver, and six thousand pieces of gold, and ten changes of raiment. And he brought the letter to the king of Israel, saying Now when this letter is come unto thee, behold, I have therewith sent Naaman my servant to thee, that thou mayest recover him of his leprosy. And it came to pass, when the king of Israel had read the letter, that he rent his clothes, and said, Am I God, to kill and to make alive, that this man doth send unto me to recover a man of his leprosy? Wherefore consider, I pray you, and see how he seeketh a guarrel against me. And it was so, when Elisha the man of God had heard that the king of Israel had rent his clothes, that he sent to the king, saying wherefore hast thou rent thy clothes? Let him come now to me, and he shall know that there is a prophet in Israel. So Naman came with his horses and with his chariot, and stood at the door of the house of Elisha. And Elisha sent a messenger unto him, saying go and wash in Jordan seven times, and thy flesh shall come again to thee, and thou shalt be clean. But Naaman was wroth, and went away, and said, Behold, I thought, He will surely come out to me, and stand and call on the name of the Lord his God and strike his hand over the place and recover the leper. Are not Abana and Pharpar, rivers of Damascus, better than all the waters of Israel? May I not wash in them, and be clean? So he turned and went away in a rage. And his servants came near, and spake unto him, and said, My father, if the prophet had bid thee do some great thing, wouldest thou not have done it? How much rather then, when he saith to thee, wash, and be clean? Then went he down, and dipped himself seven times in Jordan, according to the saying of the man of God: and his flesh came again like unto the flesh of a little child, and he was clean."



2 Kings 5:2,3

"And the Syrians had gone out by companies, and had brought away captive out of the land of Israel a little maid; and she waited on Naaman's wife. And she said unto her mistress, would God my lord were with the prophet that is in Samaria! for he would recover him of his leprosy."


Yes! He had taken captive A LITTLE MAID FROM ISRAEL who served his wife. And she one day informed Naaman's wife of the prophet in Samaria





Thus we read further of what happens next in - 2 Kings 5:4,5

"And one went in, and told his lord, saying, thus and thus said the maid that is of the land of Israel. And the king of Syria said, Go to , go and I will send a letter unto the king of Israel. And he departed and took with him ten talents of silver, and six thousand pieces of gold, and ten




Naaman was INFORMED of this and he in turn on informing THE KING was sent to the King of Israel with a letter and... he DEPARTED with ten talents of silver six thousand pieces of gold and ten changes of raiment and... A CARAVAN OF SERVANTS.

When he reached Israel and MEETS THE KING we

2 Kings 5:6,7 ught the letter

And he brought the letter to the king of Israel, saying Now when this letter is come unto thee, behold, I have therewith sent Naaman my servant to thee, that thou mayest recover him of his Ieprosy. And it came to pass, when the king of Israel had read the letter, that he rent his clothes, and said, Am I God, to kill and to make alive, that this man doth send unto me to recover a man of his Ieprosy? Wherefore consider, I pray you, and see how he seeketh a quarrel against me.




Yes! Naaman reaches Israel and duly hands over the letter to the king of Israel **REQUESTING** for Naaman's healing - which when the king of Israel read

.....HE TORE HIS ROBES and accused the king of Syria of seeking a quarrel, by expecting him to do what ONLY GOD COULD DO!


2 Kings 5:6,7

And it was so, when Elisha the man of God had heard that the king of Israel had rent his clothes, that he sent to the king, saying wherefore hast thou rent thy clothes? Let him come now to me, and he shall



Yes! In those day it was a **TERRIBLE INSULT** for a King if he could **NOT** fulfill or grant a **REQUEST** made to him!

Yes! THIS NEWS....of the meeting of Naaman and the king of Israel ...and the contents of the letter he brought with him spread like wildfire!



...AND IT REACHED THE EARS OF ELISHA THE PROPHET!

Yes! Elisha, the man of God, heard the news and SENT WORD to the king of Israel, to send Naaman to him.

And thus Naaman with his convoy.....SET OFF for Elisha's house and soon arrived at Elisha's door.

Then what do we read after this. Let us read on from - 2 Kings 5:10 -12

And Elisha sent a messenger unto him, saying go and wash in Jordan seven times, and thy flesh shall come again to thee, and thou shalt be clean. But Naaman was wroth, and went away, and said, Behold, I thought, He will surely come out to me, and stand and call on the name of the Lord his God and strike his hand over the place and recover the leper. Are not Abana and Pharpar, rivers of Damascus, better than all the waters of Israel? May I not wash in them, and be clean? So he turned and went away in rage.

Yes! There he **WAITED** and **WAITED**..... and **WAITED** but Elisha did not come out but **sent instead a messenger** with the message -

"Go and wash in Jordan seven times, and thy flesh shall come again to thee, and thou shalt be clean."

But on hearing this, Naaman was ANGRY and furious.





....There was only this message to wash **SEVEN TIMES IN** THE RIVER JORDAN.

> Yes! Another thing also made him angry!! AND THAT WAS...

.....WHY.....THE RIVER JORDAN ??

For in Syria, ABANA and PHARPAR were more beautiful rivers with sparkling water and much much, better than the River Jordan!!

And, if the prophet wanted him to wash in a river, then why not the SPARKLING RIVERS IN SYRIA.....



Why, in the River JORDAN ??

YES! HE WAS VERY ANGRY AND DISAPPOINTED ?

And thus he turned away and began his journey back to Syria.

On the way back HE HAD TO CROSS the River Jordan.



Before the crossing he must have sat on the bank of the River Jordan for a break and **WAS STILL ANGRY** and in a rage!

Thus it is that we then read from -

2 Kings 5:13-14

"And his servants came near, and spake unto him, and said, My father, if the prophet had bid thee do some great thing, wouldest thou not have done it? How much rather then, when he saith to thee, wash, and be clean? Then went he down, and dipped himself seven times in Jordan, according to the saying of the man of God: and his flesh came again like unto the flesh of a little child, and he was clean."



Yes! **SOME OF HIS SERVANTS** thus approach Naaman and address him



This shows Naaman was a good man and... was **WELL LOVED** and **RESPECTED** by his servants.

The servants speak to the angry Naaman of the SIMPLICITY of the prophet's INSTRUCTIONS and draw attention to the fact that Naaman came

....with the intention TO DO WHATEVER THE PROPHET WOULD TELL HIM AND AT WHATEVER THE COST !!



Yes! Naaman began to see REASON and.... THE POINT of the matter!

Thus his servants coaxed and convinced him to listen and obey the words of the prophet.

And Naaman finally went and did as the prophet Elisha had commanded him and when he HAD DIPPED.....THE SEVENTH TIME, his flesh

"came again like unto the flesh of a little child"



AND.....HE WAS CLEAN !!!

IT WAS AN ABSOLUTELY ASTOUNDING MIRACLE!



But **NOTE WELL** here <u>THE EXPERIENCE</u> of Naaman in the "seven dippings".

In his angry state and having been convinced by his servants

...He must have gone into the Jordan and begun his "immersing" **PROCESS**!

Perhaps <u>after each</u> "dipping" he would have looked for changes in his leprosy skin but would have found none.

....This he must have experienced SIX TIMES!

Anyone in Naaman's place would have lost his patience and thought it all a terrible joke!

Because He knew the **MEANING** and **VALUE** of instruction!

He himself was a captain and gave instructions to his

servants!

But NOT Naaman | WHY ?

And he knew that all PURPOSES are manifest only ...in THE FULFILLING OF INSTRUCTIONS!

And thus he went down that "seventh" time and IN THE FRACTION OF A SECOND A PHENOMENAL and AWESOME MIRACLE TOOK PLACE.

This brought about <u>A GREAT CHANGE IN NAAMAN</u> and he actually turned around and returned back to the prophet Elisha.

...BUT THAT IS NOT PART OF OUR LESSON TODAY!

We stop NOW..... to ponder on these "seven dippings"!

What is the <u>SIGNIFICANCE</u> of these <u>SEVEN DIPPINGS</u>?

In case one were to think this was an IMAGINARY

INCIDENT please note that JESUS HAD ALSO MENTIONED about Naaman in -

Luke 4:27

"And many lepers were in Israel in the time of Elisha the prophet and none of them was cleansed saving Naaman the Syrian."

Why?

YES! BECAUSE OF HIS FAITH!

So what is the **SPIRITUAL LESSON** we learn from this passage of scripture?

To get the answer we must FIRST understand what LEPROSY represents in God's word!

We find leprosy and lepers being referred to repeatedly in the scriptures - ...both in the OLD TESTAMENT and in the NEW TESTAMENT.

Since there are so many diseases in the world why is **LEPROSY** given so much **IMPORTANCE** and **PROMINENCE** in the scriptures? We find the answer in...the **EFFECTS** that are brought about by **LEPROSY**.

Yes! **LEPROSY** does..... <u>THREE THINGS</u> to the one who is afflicted by it.


They are -

- \longrightarrow $oldsymbol{1}$. $oldsymbol{ iny DISFIGURES}$ the image and form of the face and body.
 - **DESTROYS** the system gradually.
 - **3.** CAUSES LOSS of the SENSE of feeling.

THE LEPER BECOMES VERY TERRIBLE TO BEHOLD AND GRADUALLY DIES OVER A PERIOD OF TIME.

THE

WHAT IS LEPROSY A SYMBOL OR ... PICTURE OF ?



The SIN having spread its influence has brought "DESTRUCTION" in the MORAL, PHYSICAL, MENTAL, EMOTIONAL AND PSYCHOLOGICAL aspects of man.

Over hundreds of years SIN has caused the loss of FEELING and GUILT as man in the influence of sin are more or less VOID OF CONSCIENCE as they are

"blinded by the god of this world" - (2 Corinthians 4:4)

....and are <u>WITHOUT</u> the Holy Spirit of God.

Yes! Having understood that LEPROSY represents SIN

......then the "healing" of Naaman's leprosy through SEVEN DIPPINGS must represent the healing of the influences of sin which is as we see here to be in.....SEVEN STEPS or STAGES!!

Yes! It is a PROCESS and..... takes TIME.

This same SEVEN STEP PROCESS will be necessary EVEN in the kingdom of God for ALL MANKIND in "the common salvation" (Jude 3)

as ILLUSTRATED in the... "highway of Holiness" in Isaiah 35:8-10 and 65:20

.....to be <u>COMPLETELY AND TOTALLY RID</u> of the influences of sin.

Yes! This is because of what we read about the condition of SIN in man in -

Psalms 51:5

"Behold, I was shapen in iniquity; and in sin my mother conceived me."

Yes! For <u>ALL</u> have been "shapen in iniquity: and in sin...."

HAVE BEEN BORN!!

But today we will **ONLY** look at these "seven dippings" from the point of view of the

"so great salvation" (Hebrews 2:3) of this Gospel Age -



ARE THERE ANY LESSONS for the "CHURCH" to learn from this scripture passage today?

Yes! We read the answer in - Romans 15:4

"For whatsoever things were written <u>afore time</u> were written for our learning, that we through patience and comfort of the scriptures might have hope."

OH YES! "We" - THE CHURCH of this gospel age have MANY LESSONS for our learning in the writings - "aforetime" -the OLD TESTAMENT!!

Let us now study the SEVEN STEP PROCESS that we now go through for OUR FULL SALVATION from sin and death ...as seen through these "seven dippings" -

1.THE FIRST DIPPING OF STEP

The FIRST STEP for a SINNER when he seeks to come out of the ways of SIN.... is the exercise of FAITH.



But one CANNOT approach God except through faith as we read in -

Hebrews 11:6

"But without faith it is impossible to please Him (God)"

Ah! This Faith will be manifest IN ACCEPTING JESUS as "the saviour of the world" and even further.... as one's OWN PERSONAL SAVIOUR

For all APPROACHES towards God must be made.... ONLY THROUGH JESUS His Son as we very clearly read in -

John 14:6/10:9

"Jesus saith unto him, I am the way: no man cometh unto the father but by me."

".....I am the door (gate) ..."




➡ IT IS SO CLEAR ‼

Yes! Thus after the "FIRST" dipping.... of FAITH the condition is still in SIN but the FIRST step has been taken in the RIGHT direction - of HEALING!

Now we come to the SECOND "dipping" or step -

2. THE SECOND DIPPING OF STEP

The first step **LEADS** to the second "dipping" or STEP!



I Peter 2:2

".....<u>Desire</u> (crave - NIV) <u>the sincere milk of the word</u> that ye may grow thereby."

Yes! The "babes" in Christ must have <u>THE ALL</u>

CONSUMING PASSION TO STUDY THE BIBLE as seen in the desire and FOCUS of babes at their mother's breasts when drinking milk!

Here further we see that... the truth also acts as <u>A WATER</u>
<u>OF CLEANSING</u> as we read in -

Ephesians 5:26


"....Sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word"

Yes! The Bible or the "word of God" has a **CLEANSING** or "**SANCTIFYING**" effect upon the sinner as we read very clearly in -

John 17:17
"Sanctify them through thy truth:
thy word is truth."

Yes! That is why the **WORD** is symbolized as "**WATER**".

Just as water is used to dissolve and cleanse DIRT so too......the REAL DIRT of sin is cleansed through......the WORD OF GOD.



The reading of the Bible draws to attention one's **SINFUL CONDITION** and **WAYS** in....the thoughts,....words

and....deeds!!

Anyone who reads the Bible gets a clear understanding of his/her sinful condition and is thus greatly influenced to **REFORM** and **REPENT**!

Thus REPENTANCE BEGINS here in the heart!!

Thus the "second dipping" makes ready for the next!

3.THE THIRD DIPPING or STEP

The gradual "cleansing" and BIBLE STUDYING progresses as the "babe" in Christ seeks more and more to be

a little more like Christ - or CHRISTIAN. !

This is the stage where **ONE BEGINS PUTTING AWAY** wicked ways and habits!!

This the work of the "Holy Spirit" within as we read in - John 16:8

"When he comes he will <u>CONVICT</u> the world of guilt in regard to sin and righteousness and judgement." (NIV)

This shows that it is the measure of God's Holy Spirit (God's "calling") "within" that begins to convict us and.....OBEDIENCE to the Spirit brings the separation or "sacrifice" of bad things!!



Thus it is that at this stage THE CHRISTIAN "babe" or BELIEVER will say and make TESTIMONIES such as -

"I was secretly a smoker and I thought nobody knew of my habit but then when I began to read the Bible I came to know that GOD ALWAYS KNOWS and I decided to stop completely..."

Another will say - "I was so crazy about seeing films I would be always seeing the new release in the theaters on the first day itself - whatever the cost of the ticket!

But now I DON'T HAVE THAT SAME FEELING any more."

Another will say - "I would speak bad language in my speech casually and without thinking as it was common among my friends. I would think nothing of it, but NOW I realize how it DISPLEASES GOD and so I AM CAREFUL IN MY WORDS now...."

Yet another will say - "I used to drink everyday.

It was a regular habit of mine to meet with my friends at the local bar everyday and spend time till late in the night. But NOW I CAN'T SEEM TO DO THAT anymore....."

And thus the TESTIMONIES of "SACRIFICE OF THESE BAD HABITS" will go on and on....!

This could be said to be a state of PARTIAL CONSECRATION to God and to righteousness - a step in the right direction!!

This "dipping" leads then to the "fourth dipping" -

4.11HE FOURTH DIPPING or SITEP

This "dipping" or STEP which follows

is....A FULL CONSECRATION of one's whole will AND....LIFE TO DO the Lord's will.



This is understood by a <u>deeper</u>

<u>study</u> of the word of God where
the mere "BELIEVER" in Christ
begins to understand a lot more
depth to the Christian "calling" as
we read in -

Philippians 1:29

"For unto you it is given in the behalf of Christ, <u>not only to believe on him,</u> <u>but also to suffer for his sake."</u>

And again a similar thought in
I Peter 2:21

"For even hereunto were ye called: because Christ also suffered for us <u>leaving us an example</u>, that ye should follow his steps."

Yes! Thus understanding that **BELIEVING** in Jesus is.....the **FIRST** stage of Christian development and recognizing the need to go to the **NEXT** stage and to....become

a FOLLOWER of Jesus the Christian then experiences a TRANSFORMATION OF MIND as he beholds the words of the Master in -

Matthew 16:24

"Then said Jesus unto his disciples, if any man will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross and follow me."

Yes! The meaning of these words and their SIGNIFICANCE begins to dawn on the Christian and he understands that to - "deny self" is....to DENY the spirit of this world the SELF CENTERED life of "self will"!

Thus the Apostle Paul describes the experiences of a Christian at this stage in -

Romans 12:2

"And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good and acceptable, and perfect will of God."



Yes! The willingness to OBEY and DENY the "spirit of this world" causes a RENEWAL of the mind which empties itself of "the spirit of the world" BIT by BIT and....then INSPIRED by God's HOLY SPIRIT is able to DISCERN -

"that good ,and acceptable and perfect will of God."

Yes! In one word this refers to..... - THE CROSS!

The Christian who decides to follow Jesus is called to.....take up his cross

What does the sight of Jesus on the CROSS bring to mind?

> Yes! It is His great SACRIFICE OF HIS LIFE to

become the savior of the world!

Thus it is that His disciples are invited to follow Him and....HIS FOOTSTEPS!

Let us now read the words of the Apostle Paul describing this **VERY** matter in -

Romans 12:1

"I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice holy acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service."

These are the thoughts of.....a FULL CONSECRATION to do the Lord's will by the "transforming of the mind" and....the "denial of will" (self will) and thus....our "bodies" (The flesh and its interests - the human life) is presented.....as a 'living sacrifice".

NOW WHAT IS IT THAT WE CAN SACRIFICE?



This sacrifice includes....dreams / goals / ambitions / time / talents / wealth / health and life itself!

Those Christians who take this step "to follow Jesus" are referred to by the Heavenly Father in a very special way as we read in -

Psalms 50:5

"Gather my saints unto me, those that have made a covenant with me by sacrifice."

Yes! These are....THE REAL "saints" OF GOD!

This step of FULL CONSECRATION is entered into by the making of a COVENANT with God, as was with Our Lord,

Jesus too as we read in -

Hebrews 10:7

"Then said I, Lo, I come (in the volume of the book it is written to me,) to do thy will, O God."



Yes! This "covenant of sacrifice of self will" unto death is beautifully



SYMBOLIZED in WATER BAPTISM.

(We studied the details of its meaning is LESSON # 17 - THE CHURCH OF CHRIST - I)

Thus this fourth "dipping" leads to the "fifth dipping".

5.THE FIFTH DIPPING OF STEP

The fifth "dipping" involves a **PRACTICAL FULFILLING**



.....of that which we vowed.

Yes! The making of the COVENANT or vow with God is wonderful but <u>GREATER</u> IS THE actual FULFILLMENT of THE DOING of that VOW as we read in -

Psalms 116:14

"I will pay my vows unto the Lord now in the presence of all His people."

Yes! This should be the attitude <u>every moment and....</u>, <u>everyday</u> in the consecrated ones.

Such an ATTITUDE then leads to a QUICKENING or a growth in the CHRISTIAN FOLLOWER

as he begins to develop in the "image of the Son" (Romans 8:29) Yes?

Herein begins a **DEVELOPMENT PROCESS** that is described in -

II Corinthians 5:17

"Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new".

Yes! Such Christians who have gone on from being BELIEVERS

in Jesus to becoming His FOLLOWERS and to be "in Christ" or.....so as to be part of the SACRIFICING BODY OF CHRIST becomes what is called..... A NEW CREATURE!



Now what is this "new creature" you may want to know ?

It is the MOST IMPORTANT ASPECT of a Christian from God's stand point as we read very clearly in -

Galatians 6:15

"For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision (A JEW) availeth anything, nor uncircumcision (A GENTILE) but a new creature."

Yes! Neither being a Jew or a gentile is important but what does matter is -



....."the new creature".

This "new creature" is described in –

Colossians 3:9,10

"Lie not one to another, seeing that ye have put off the old man with his deeds and have put on the new man, which is renewed in knowledge after the image of him that created him".


> Here the "new man" is a reference to the NEW CREATURE.

The NEW CREATURE has both "the old man" and the "new man" !!

This is a reference to the TWO MINDS in a FOLLOWER OF CHRIST!

He has both an EARTHLY MIND which he had possessed

from his birth and SPIRITUAL MIND which he received from God at his "spirit" begettal!



(THE DETAILED IN DEPTH STUDY OF THE NEW CREATURE WILL BE TAKEN UP IN CLASS # 41)


But ONE MIND (the earthly) is considered to be dead.....or is gradually put to death.....with all its ways, desires, behaviors and actions BEING UNDER STRICT SURVEILLANCE and NOT ALLOWED FREE EXPRESSION ANYMORE.

And the OTHER MIND (the Spiritual) is considered to be alive...and all thoughts, words and deeds are gradually made SUBJECT to this SPIRITUAL MIND.

The DEVELOPMENT of the NEW SPIRITUAL MIND is the PRIMARY GOAL and OBJECTIVE of a "NEW CREATURE" Christian.

Thus he must be **FAITHFUL** in **DAILY** fulfilling his **CONSECRATION VOWS!**

FAITHFULNESS in fulfilling consecration vows makes one strong to face all trials which must come as we read very clearly in -



Let us read the answer from -

I Peter 1:7

"....That the TRIAL OF YOUR FAITH being much more precious than of gold that perisheth though it be tried with fire, might be found unto praise and honour and glory at the appearing of Jesus Christ."

YES! IT IS A TRIAL OF OUR FAITH!

In all our experiences of life having KNOWN GOD and...

HIS SON JESUS and... THE DIVINE PLAN in the Word of God the only thing we can offer to God is... OUR FAITH

IN HIM and that is what is

TESTED in the Christian's "walk of life".

These "tests of faith" are through BOTH "bitter" and "sweet"!!

Thus it is that the FIFTH "dipping" leads to the SIXTH!

6.THE SIXTH DIPPING or STEP

This is the "dipping" or STEP that involves the

and the attaining of the "mark" of perfect love.

WHAT IS LOVE and....how can it be defined?

LOVE cannot be defined along with TWO other things ...LIGHT and LIFE !!

Yes! These all have their SOURCE in God and God has



Thus this quality of **LOVE** can best be understood by its manifestation or "fruitage" as we read described in -

Galatians 5:22

"But the FRUIT of the spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith.

This "FRUITAGE" of love is first manifest UNSEEN andIN THE MIND of the Christian who <u>earnestly desires</u> to develop those qualities in himself or herself!!

And, Yes! This CULTIVATION of love though is a process A GRADUAL PROCESS of growth as....in a TREE!



First is the SEED which is God's Word.... and then the ROOT which is faith..... and then the STEM (the works and service of the Lord)and then FLOWERS (Christian experiences) which then finallybrings forth FRUIT - the fruit of GOD AND CHRIST'S LOVE.

These fruit of love and its manifestation are explained thus -

FAITH

LOVE in the battle field (of opposition and unbelief)

SELF CONTROL

LOVE in training.

GOODNESS

LOVE in action.

JOY

LOVE in exultation (rejoicing)

PEACE

LOVE in repose or rest

GENTLENESS

LOVE in society

MEEKNESS

LOVE in resignation (willingness to listen)

LONGSUFFERING LOVE enduring patiently

Thus it is that we read of THE CHRISTIAN AND WHAT
HIS ATTITUDE SHOULD BE IN -

Galatians 6:10

"....<u>Let us do good unto ALL MEN</u> especially unto them who are of the household of faith."



Yes! This CAN ONLY be out of A HEART OF LOVE which becomesESTABLISHED AND GROUNDED in the "NEW CREATURE" as this TRANSFORMATION of CHARACTER takes place WITHIN as described in -

II Corinthians 5:17

"Therefore <u>if any man be in Christ</u>, he is a new creature old things are passed away; behold all things are become new."

Yes! Indeed the Christian at this stage of development has a CHARACTER DEVELOPMENT of love which is manifest in -

.... "love of RIGHTEOUSNESS and hatred of INIQUITY"

....And further in <u>LOVING</u> the SINNER and..... HATING the SIN!!

Yes! This UNDERSTANDING is what causes the Christian "new creature" at this stage of development to LOVE even those who OPPOSE and.....PERSECUTE him.....his ENEMIES!! Yes! The Christian is now developing.... in "the image of the Son".

7. THE SEVENTH DIPPING OF STEP

Having "dipped" in the Jordan a sixth time and reached THE MARK OF PERFECT LOVE

the "seventh" dipping is to "stand" or maintain that mark at all costs....even unto death.

This we read of very clearly in -

Ephesians 6:13

"Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done ALL, to stand."

Yes! The "DOING ALL" represents..... THE PREVIOUS
SIX "dippings" or STEPS and having come to the MARK of
perfect love!

This <u>FINAL TESTING AND TRIAL</u> we read of again described in -

Matthew 24:13 / Revelation 2:10 "But he that shall endure unto the end the same be saved."

"....Be thou faithful unto death, and i will give thee a crown of life."

Yes! All the GREAT PROMISES are for enduring <u>TILL</u>
THE END.....that is unto death!

These TRIALS OF ENDURANCE ARE like a FINAL EXAMINATION that <u>BOTH</u> tests and.....manifests THE DEPTH and THE QUALITY OF all the wonderful Christ like CHARACTER DEVELOPMENT developed painstakingly over a long period of time by the Christian in his/her LIFETIME.



Thus it is that we read in - James 1:4

"Let <u>patience have her perfect work</u>, that ye may be perfect and ENTIRE wanting nothing."

Yes! It is the WISDOM of God that this PATIENT

ENDURANCE brings forth..... PERFECT COMPLETION !!

These are the **FINAL** "**GRADUATING**" experiences of a Christian that serve to **POLISH** the Christ - like character already developed and **CRYSTALLIZED** within!

It is like when a sculpture is carved out of stone, the process is.....LONG and PAINSTAKING but the beauty of the work is manifestedONLY when the FINAL



......So too it is with the Christian and his / her CHRIST - LIKE CHARACTER DEVELOPMENT!

<u>AND FINALLY</u> having "dipped" in the Jordan the "seventh" time the transformation **ACHIEVED** is as we read in -

Psalms 17:15

"As for me I will behold thy face in righteousness: <u>I shall be satisfied</u>, when I awake, with thy likeness."

Yes! This is a picture of the Christian coming out of the Jordan <u>AFTER the "seventh dipping"</u>!!

This is a picture of....THE FIRST RESURRECTION when the Church receives "the likeness" of God and Jesus -



....YES! THE DIVINE NATURE!

What does the words - "....I shall be satisfied..." mean?



It could mean two things as we read hereunder -

1. The SATISFACTION of "deliverance" from the miserably weak body of the flesh and sin as we read in -

Romans 7:24 - 0 wretched man that I am! Who shall deliver me from the body of this death?



2. The SATISFACTION of the "reward" far beyond one's expectation for the sacrifices and sufferings of the Christian walk of life (I John 3:2)

FINALLY WHAT IS MEANT BY THESE "SEVEN DIPPINGS" BEING..... IN THE RIVER JORDAN ???

As we have already studied in a previous lesson (in CLASS # 16) THE RIVER JORDAN REPRESENTS THE

COURSE OF MANKIND IN THE FIRST AND SECOND WORLDS when the INHERITED SIN and DEATH CONDITION is upon ALL!

Thus these "seven dippings" or SEVEN STEP PROCESS for a Christian in THE GOSPEL AGE

.....is while he is <u>IN</u> and <u>AMONG</u> that same "fallen" condition in himself....and....the world around him - Yes!...."THE RIVER JORDAN"!!

FINALLY the world of mankind too in THEIR PERIOD OF SALVATION in the MILLENNIAL AGE will go through a similar SEVEN STEP PROCESS as we read in -

II Kings 4:35

"Then he returned and walked in the house to and fro; and went up, and stretched himself upon him; and the child sneezed seven times, and the child opened his eyes."

Yes! The "child" here represents THE WORLD OF MANKIND
....who will have their "eyes" opened from death to life but only after.... SNEEZING SEVEN TIMES
- which represents a SEVEN STEP PROCESS.
