
Lessons on **Prayer**



"Thy word is truth" ...John 17:17




PLEASE NOTE: Kindly refer to your Bibles for every scripture reference and read thoroughly.

MOST SCRIPTURE PASSAGES ARE QUOTED FROM THE AUTHORISED KING JAMES VERSION (KJV)

Today we will take up the study of a subject <u>VERY DEAR</u> to most Christians but very generally.....NOT CLEARLY UNDERSTOOD!

Yes! Today we will be studying lessons about Prayer:-



have a COMMUNION with GOD.

Even Christians of <u>ALL</u> the various denominations and churches give a lot of **TIME** and **IMPORTANCE** to prayer.

Infact, PRAYER has come to be considered as

EVEN MORE IMPORTANT than even Bible study!!

Thus it is that we see -

PRAYER MEETINGS, FASTING &
PRAYER, ALL NIGHT PRAYERS, CHAIN
PRAYERS ETC.

SO, WHAT REALLY IS PRAYER?

PRAYER is a general term used to describe all manner of PRAISE or THANKSGIVING or PETITIONS or REQUESTS unto God.

YES! IT IS
PERSONAL AND
DIRECT
COMMUNICATION
WITH GOD.



This much we ALL know about prayer!

Now we are going to study about something **WE DON'T KNOW ABOUT PRAYER!!**

Yes! From the BIBLE POINT OF VIEW <u>PRAYER</u> is a <u>PRIVILEGE</u> which as the word itself implies is **OPEN** and **AVAILABLE** to......only a **SELECT FEW**!!

$ilde{ iny}$ THIS MAY COME AS A SURPRISE FOR MANY!

But let us learn from the Master Himself!

He never EVER asked the crowds that He spoke to and preached to DAILY to PRAY!!

And now notice ANOTHER

ASTONISHING matter which we read in -

John 17:9

" I pray for them: I pray NOT for the world but for them which thou hast given me.."






The **SAVIOUR** of the **WORLD** Himself **DOES NOT** pray for the world!!

Can you believe it?!

WHY DID JESUS SAY THIS ????



To understand this matter clearly we must FIRST study the **HISTORY** of the relationship between God and Man!!



Yes! These words of CAIN represent the CONDITION of fallen mankind -

"...from thy face shall I be hid.."

THIS REPRESENTS....A SEPARATION FROM GOD !!

AND INDEED! ALL MANKIND SINCE THEN HAVE BEEN SEPARATED FROM GOD AND HAVE FORGOTTEN THE KNOWLEDGE OF THEIR CREATOR !!


Thus it is written of the world during God's kingdom when their "eyes of understanding" will be OPENED in -

Psalms 22:27 "All the ends of the world shall REMEMBER and turn unto the LORD..."



Thus GENERALLY all mankind have LOST SIGHT OF and

..... FORGOTTENtheir GOD and CREATOR!



But these were **mere INDIVIDUALS**!!

There was **ENOCH** and **NOAH** and ABRAHAM and ISAAC and JACOB and JOB. These had the KNOWLEDGE of God and prayed to Him!

Then after the death of Jacob, God then said to the children of Jacob thus in -

Amos 3:2



treasure unto me above all people: for all the earth is mine."

Yes! This was the LAW COVENANT given to them through Moses on Mount Sinai!

In this special COVENANT relationship God gave to Israel the AARONIC PRIESTHOOD to serve between God and the people and their SINS were ATONED for annually through the ATONEMENT DAY SACRIFICES which we see recorded in the 16th chapter of the BOOK of LEVITICUS.

Thus being "cleansed" and in covenant relationship with God the NATION OF ISRAEL could then approach

God in prayer!

They ALONE had the KNOWLEDGE and the PRIVILEGE!!



This was during the period called.....

THE JEWISH AGE - and extended from Jacob's death to the FIRST ADVENT of Our Lord Jesus Christ.

B.C.1813 to **A.D.33**-

Thus it is that we read in -

John 4:22

"Ye worship ye know not what: we know what we worship:


for salvation is of the Jews."

These are the words of Jesus Christ to the Samaritan woman at the well!

Jesus is speaking on behalf of the "JEWS" - the name given to the people of "JUDAH. "or"......JUDEA"

Notice Jesus said that the JEWS KNEW GOD whom they worshiped.





We read the answer in -

John 4:12

"Art thou greater than OUR FATHER JACOB, which gave us the well...."

Yes! The Samaritan claims to have Jacob as her "father"!

HOW COME? AND HOW IS IT POSSIBLE?

Yes! the Samaritan woman was also of Israel; BUT OF THE SEPARATED 10-TRIBE NATION OF ISRAEL whose capital was Samaria!

Though they worshiped God it was a blind worship of rituals, without much knowledge.

They had become almost like the gentiles.

At the end of the Jewish age ISRAEL were in two parts

- the nation of JUDAH and the nation of ISRAEL.

God's blessings and favor was upon Judah who is represented as the "rich man" in the parable of the RICHMAN &



But soon after, the Jewish Age ended as we read these words of Jesus in –

Matthew 23:37,38

"O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, thou that killest the prophets, and stonest them which are sent unto thee, how often would I have gathered thy children together, even as a hen gathereth her chickens under her wings, and ye would not! Behold, your house is left unto you DESOLATE....."


These words were spoken by Jesus in the year 33 A.D. a little before **HE DIED**!!

In that same year about 8-10 weeks later on the day of **PENTECOST BEGAN** a **NEW** Age in God's Plan.

...AND THE TERMS TO KNOW AND ENTER INTO A RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD HAD CHANGED!! About the new "conditions" we read in

John 14:6


"I AM THE WAY.....no man cometh to the Father, but BY Me......"



They could NO MORE DIRECTLY approach God <u>as they had</u> <u>been doing until then.</u>

They now had to **ACKNOWLEDGE** and come through **JESUS** who was... "the way."

But the great MAJORITY REJECTED "the way"



and they were cut off from favor and fellowship with God as represented by -

"the gulf"

In the parable of the "Rich Man and Lazarus" which we read in -

Luke 16:26

"And besides all this between us and you there is a great gulf fixed..."

Nevertheless the FEW that believed entered into THE SPECIAL FAVOR OF GOD -

THE CHRIST - IAN BLESSING!

This favor and "calling" was later extended even to the nonjews - THE GENTILES!

We read of the details of this very clearly in -

Acts 10:1-2 / 45

"There was a certain man in Caesarea called Cornelius, a centurion of the band called the Italian band. A devout man, and one that feared God with all his house, which gave much alms to the people, and prayed to God always".

"And they of the circumcision which believed were astonished, as many as came with Peter, because that on the gentiles also was poured out the gift of the holy Ghost."

Yes! Cornelius and his family were the FIRST of the gentiles to be accepted!!



ALL "believers" HAVE THE PRIVILEGE OF PRAYING TO GOD- THROUGH JESUS.

But the "believer" stage is only the <u>FIRST</u> stage of the Christian "walk of life" and is the early stage of being "babes" (I Peter 2:2) spiritually!!

Christian "believers" of Jesus are "CALLED" to be......
"FOLLOWERS" of HIM as we read in -

I Peter 2:21

"For even hereunto were ye called, because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that ye should FOLLOW HIS STEPS...."



BUT VERY FEW AMONG CHRISTIANS UNDERSTAND THIS MATTER

".....for MANY are called, but FEW are chosen"

(NIV) Matthew 22:14

It is for THESE <u>FOLLOWERS</u> that the PRIVILEGE of prayer is offered during this Gospel Age!



This we read very clearly in -

Hebrews 4:16

"Let <u>us</u> therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need."

Here the "us" refers to that CLASS of..... "FOLLOWERS"



the FORGIVENESS of their sins and the cleansing of their ROBES of RIGHTEOUSNESS (Isaiah 61:10)



the SPIRITUAL STRENGTH to withstand TRIALS and TESTINGS in the Christian walk.

Yes! PRAYER is VERY IMPORTANT for their PROGRESS "daily" and "hourly" in the NARROW WAY!!

But for many Christians the QUESTION asked is the SAME ONE asked by the disciples so many years ago which we read in -

Luke 11:1

"....one of His disciples said unto him, Lord teach us to pray..."





Yes! HOW DO WE PRAY?

ISN'T THAT YOUR QUESTION TOO?

In reply Our Lord begins the **LESSON** on how to pray in -

Matthew 6:9 "After this manner pray ye..."





This is **NOT** a prayer to repeat again and again but rather is an **OUTLINE** or **MODEL** of prayer.

Now let us learn of the Lord the LESSONS ON HOW TO PRAY.

We begin by-



MATTHEW 6:9

".....Our Father which art in Heaven....."

Yes! All prayer must be <u>FIRST</u> of all properly addressed to "the Father", of whom and regarding whom Jesus said in -

John 17:3

"that they might know thee THE ONLY TRUE GOD"

Yes! And again the Apostle Paul taught us the same in -

I Corinthians 8:6

"To us there is **BUT ONE GOD, THE FATHER...**.."

Yes! And again the Apostle Paul taught us the same in -

I Corinthians 8:6

"To us there is BUT ONE GOD, THE FATHER....."

Today a great MAJORITY of
Christians HAVE LOST SIGHT

OF this "great truth" and
address their prayers to Jesus,
thinking him to be the
Father....and GOD HIMSELF!



It is a privilege to know God and to call Him, "Father" for the Jews had <u>NO</u> SUCH PRIVILEGE for the great privilege of "sonship" was only given to, as we read in -

John 1:12

"But as many as received him to them gave he POWER to become the SONS of GOD"

DID YOU SEE THAT ??!... "gave He POWER...."

Yes! And again the Apostle John writes of the same in -

I John 3:1

"Behold what manner of love the Father hath bestowed upon us, that we should be called the SONS OF GOD.."

OH! WHAT AN AWESOME PRIVILEGE
WE HAVE !!

Yes! All PRAYER must be addressed to THE FATHER and GOD of all (Ephesians 3:14, 15).

Note Jesus own example of prayer in -

John 17:1

These words spake Jesus and lifted up his eyes to heaven and said, <u>Father, the</u> hour is come..."

And the next lesson after that is -



Yes! Having addressed the Father-the GOD of all creation and the Universe we must look unto Him

in ADORATION and PRAISE.



There is <u>SO MUCH TO PRAISE IN GOD</u>

Yes! His **PERFECTION**.....in justice, wisdom, power and love and of His unimaginable glory -



"....who lives in unapproachable light....."

SOME EXAMPLES OF PRAISE, IN ADDRESSING THE FATHER ARE -

Isaiah 57:15 -(ISAIAH)

"the High and Lofty one that inhabiteth eternity, whose name is Holy"

"the God of Our Lord Jesus Christ, the - Ephesians 1:17 father of Glory..." (APOSTLE RAUL)

James 1:17 -(APOSTLE JAMES)

"...the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning...."

I will praise thy name forever and ever. Great is the Lord and greatly to be praised and His greatness is unsearchable...."

- Psalms 145:2, 3 (KING DAVID)

(NEHEMIAH)

Nehemiah 9:6 - "You alone are the Lord you made the heavens even the highest heavens, and all their starry host, the earth and all that is on it, the seas and all that is in them.,."

"There is none holy as the lord; for there is none beside thee; neither is there any Rock like our God!"

- I Samuel 2:2 (HANNAH)

YES! THUS ONE CAN GO ON ... THE LIST IS ENDLESS!

Ah! And after praising and adoring God the Father, the next lesson is -



MATTHEW 6:10

".....thy kingdom come, Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven."

The next thought that must come to mind is God's Word and in it the glorious DIVINE PLAN FOR MAN and THE GOSPEL OF THE KINGDOM.

We recognize
that kingdom "to
come" is in its

<u>EMBRYONIC</u>
stage -

in the <u>ONGOING</u>
development process
of the church in the

Thus it is that we read of the CHURCH in -



"...and hath translated us into the Kingdom of his dear son."

Yes! the church is being selected to be of the SPIRITUAL INVISIBLE

PHASE of the Kingdom of God under

the rulership of Jesus -



...... the "King of kings and Lord of lords".

Thus the prayer for ALL members of this church and their

..... DEVELOPMENT and..... THE WORK OF THE HARVEST is the praying of

"...thy kingdom come,..."

Every passing day brings us **CLOSER** and **CLOSER** to the coming of this Kingdom and the complete fulfillment of this prayer.

"....thy will be done in earth as it is in heaven."

Yes! The ACTUAL ESTABLISHMENT OF THIS KINGDOM on EARTH......at the SECOND COMING of JESUS is the fulfillment of this part of the prayer.

Now we come to the FOURTH lesson in -



MATTHEW 6:11

"Give us this day our daily bread"

Many mistake this request for the <u>LITERAL</u> bread of food and sustenance.

But \underline{NOTE} the Master's commands on this matter \underline{in} -

Matthew 6:8

"Be <u>NOT</u> ye therefore like unto them: for your Father knoweth what things ye have need of, <u>before</u> ye ask him."

(Please also read Matthew 6:31,32)



Yes! We are to TRUST God for ALL of our temporal needs of food, clothing and shelter for it is written in -

Hebrews 13:5

"....for he hath said, I will <u>NEVER</u> leave thee <u>NOR</u> forsake three...."

(Please also read Isaiah 33:16)
Yes! What a most wonderful
ASSURANCE from the LORD GOD
Himself!

Then WHAT is the "daily bread" being referred to over here?

It is the SPIRITUAL "bread" of God's word as we read in -

Jeremiah 15:16

"Thy words were found, and I did eat them..."

Yes! The CHURCH DAILY needs God's WORDS of GUIDANCE for......SPIRITUAL GROWTH andLIFE.

This "daily bread" also signifies a DAILY seeking for the Holy Spirit of God as we read in -

Luke 11:11-13

"...how much more shall your Heavenly
Father give the Holy Spirit to them that ask
Him."

Yes! The HOLY SPIRIT must be prayed for <u>DAILY</u> as the "oil"

that brings forth the "light" from the "lamp" of God's Word.

<u>PLEASE NOTE</u>: The words "give us" and "our" CLEARLY suggest that prayer be for the WELFARE and PROVIDENCE of the whole Body of Christ as a family rather than ONLY for self!

Now we come to the **FIFTH** of our lessons in <u>Prayer</u> -



MATTHEW 6:12

"....and forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors.."

What is meant by these "debts"?

They refer to our SINS!

Thus this refers to the CONFESSION of sins and

THE SEEKING FOR FORGIVENESS.

Having received the "heavenly gift" which we read in Hebrews 6:4 of JUSTIFICATION from sin through.....faith in Jesus' sacrifice,

the Christian is said to be thus wearing a "robe of righteousness" (Isaiah 61:10)



But this "spotless" robe is "soiled" (made dirty) with EVERY SIN COMMITTED AFTER THAT!



These "marks" must be washed away.

HOW, YOU MAY ASK? !

We read of how in -

I John 1:9-10

"If we CONFESS our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to CLEANSE us from all unrighteousness...."

Yes! Forgiveness of sins is gained by a Christian through the CONFESSION OF THE SINS COMMITTED.



But in asking for the "forgiveness of our debts" - SINS - we must keep one principle in mind as recorded in the words of the Lord in -

Matthew 6:14,15

"For if ye forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. But if ye forgive NOT men their trespasses, neither will your father forgive your trespasses."

Yes! Here is God's <u>CONDITIONS</u> FOR THE FORGIVENESS OF OUR SINS -



......TO FORGIVE those who have sinned against you!

INDEED! WHAT A MARVELLOUS PRINCIPLE!!!



But here God makes it clear that the more forgiveness we seek from him -

CORRESPONDINGLY THE MORE WE NEED TO FORGIVE OTHERS AND THEIR WRONGS DONE UNTO US.

Just think about this!

Just CLOSE your eyes for a moment.....and think about all the SINS of yours that you need GOD to FORGIVE you and then.....think about all the WRONGS and SINS others have done unto you and which you have the OPTION to FORGIVE |



WILL you FORGIVE?

A LITTLE BIT ? Or ALL !!

Then YOUR SINS too TO THAT EXTENT will find FORGIVENESS with God!



Imagine how much of TENSIONS, BLOOD PRESSURE PROBLEMS, HEART ATTACKS and STROKES can be

AVOIDED if one only PUT..... THIS PRINCIPLE OF GOD INTO PRACTICE!

This principle helps to develop the "golden" - GODLIKE - grace of MERCY towards one's fellow men.

Now we reach the **SIXTH** lesson of prayer -



MATTHEW 6:13

"...and lead us NOT into temptation, but deliver us from evil"



And we read of the **EXPERIENCES** of a Christian in the "narrow way" in -

James 1:2,12

"My brethren, count it all JOY when ye fall into divers temptations."

"BLESSED is the man that endureth temptation..."

And again in the words of Apostle Peter in -

I Peter 4:12

"Beloved, think it not strange concerning the FIERY TRIAL which is to try you..."

and again in -

I Peter 1:6

"Wherein ye greatly rejoice, though now for a season, if need be, ye are in heaviness through manifold temptations...."

Yes! All these scriptures speak of **REJOICINGLY**.....entering into "temptations"!!

But before we understand the **DEPTH** of this matter let us **NOTE** that there are **TWO MEANINGS** of "temptation" in this first chapter of James and their

MEANINGS.....GREATLY DIFFER!

Let us see that verse in - James 1:13

"Let no man say when he is tempted, I am tempted of God: for God CANNOT be tempted with evil, neither tempteth he any man.



This "temptation" mentioned here refers to THE FALLEN AND DEPRAVED DESIRES of the flesh and.....the PLEASURES of sin.






Yes! This is a temptation that DOES NOT COME FROM GOD!

But the "temptation" from God to the Christian is one of TRIAL to TEST.....and.....PROVE FAITH and.....to develop CHARACTER ATTRIBUTES.

Now coming back to the scripture it seems to say "lead us NOT into "trials"



Do we pray to God to NOT give us any TRIALS?

.....Or to TAKE AWAY all the TRIALS ??



Most DEFINITELY NOT !!

For, remember the words of the Apostle James in Chapter 1 and verse 2 and 12 where he says it is GREAT JOY to fall into TRIALS and a great BLESSING too - because THROUGH those very TRIALS one becomes WORTHY to receive the "CROWN OF LIFE" !!



Here the word "lead" could be better translated as -"abandon" or



Yes! This is a reference to the PLEA for the promised "GRACE TO HELP" from the Lord in those TRIALS as found in His precious PROMISES in His word in -

Hebrews 13:5

"for he hath said, I will NEVER leave thee nor forsake thee..."

and again in -

Matthew 28:20

"...l am with you always, even unto the end of the world..."

YES! IS'NT IT VERY CLEAR?

Thus the Apostle Paul wrote to every fellow Christian in the midst of his/her TRIALS and "temptations" to pray for GRACE as we read in -

Hebrews 4:16

"... come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain <u>MERCY</u> and find <u>GRACE</u> to help in time of need."

Yes! Isn't it VERY CLEAR that the prayer is NOT to TAKE

AWAY the "temptations" but rather for the STRENGTH to

BEAR and OVERCOME the TRIALS!!



And now we come to **the second half** of the verse - "...but deliver us from evil..."

What does this mean?

This refers to the evil WITHIN OURSELVES -

Yes! The **WEAKNESSES OF THE FLESH**, for which the Evil One, Satan, is always looking for an opportunity to arouse in us as we read in -

Matthew 26:41

"Watch and pray that ye enter <u>NOT</u> into temptation, the spirit indeed is WILLING, but the flesh is weak...."

This refers to all the sins and weaknesses of our FLESH

and <u>MIND</u>.....from which the Lord <u>ALONE</u> can deliver us and give us the **VICTORY**!



Each one of us knows ONE'S own particular weakness and we must FIGHT A GOOD FIGHT over it and NOT SAY-

"I AM LIKE THIS ONLY."

Then only will one get the GRACE from the LORD to OVERCOME!



YES! IT IS A BATTLE UNTO DEATH!

Here <u>TOO</u> we see the word "us" showing that the prayers must also include the thought of other members of the Body of Christ IN SIMILAR CONDITIONS.

The <u>SEVENTH</u> AND LAST lesson in prayer and a very important one is found in -



Colossians 3:17

"And whatsoever you do in word or deed, do all IN THE NAME of the Lord Jesus...."

Yes! The concluding thoughts of <u>ALL</u> prayer <u>MUST</u> be to remember the Master who was the one who gave us the great <u>PRIVILEGE</u> to approach the Father and to "ask" in prayer as we read very clearly in -

John 16:23,24

"Verily, Verily, I say unto you, whatsoever ye shall <u>ask the Father IN MY NAME</u>, He will give it youask, and ye shall receive, that your joy may be full."

Yes! It is ONLY THROUGH THE SON

that one can reach the Father!

For we are **NEVER** to forget the words of the Lord in -

John 15:5 "....for without me you can do NOTHING..."

Thus the CONCLUDING THOUGHT of all prayer to God is to remember and acknowledge the Son and the great HEAD (Ephesians 1:22) of us all.



It is but appropriate that ONE **BEGINS** his/her prayers by looking to THE FATHER and..... CONCLUDES by looking to THE SON!



For are NOT ALL things OF the Father and....THROUGH the Son?

FINALLY IN CONCLUSION

Apostle Paul to the

Thessalonians in -

I Thessalonians 5:17

"....pray without ceasing..."

WHAT DOES THAT MEAN?





Does that mean we pray ALL THE TIME.....DAY AND NIGHT andNEGLECT all other duties of family and work?



NOST DEFINITELY NOT !!

For we very clearly read of the duties to family and loved ones in -

I Timothy 5:8

"But if any provide not for his own, and specially for those of his own house, he hath denied the faith and is worst than an infidel."

Yes! It is a CHRISTIAN DUTY to look after the needs of one's family.



Then what is the thought here of -

"praying without ceasing..."

Here the thought is that PRAYER is to become



A CEASELESS PART OF THE CHRISTIAN'S LIFE

in the form of -

....PRAYER AS A CHURCH (GROUP) 🖛



....FAMILY PRAYER 🛹



....INDIVIDUAL PRIVATE PRAYER. 🔷



YES! WE ARE TO BE.....PRAYING ("without ceasing") CHRISTIANS!

This "praying without ceasing" COULD ALSO represent
a PRAYERFUL MANNER of living one's life - always seeking
the Lord's GUIDANCE and WILL in every matter
of the day to day life!!



Yes!....LOOKING UNTO the Lord always!

In this we have A MOST WONDERFUL EXAMPLE
in Our Lord and Master Jesus Christ,
of whom it is written in -

Hebrews 5:7

"Who in the days of his flesh, when he had offered up prayers and supplications with strong crying and tears unto him that was able to save him from death, and was heard in that he feared."

YES! WHAT AN EXAMPLE TO LEARN FROM!

Yes! Dear brethren and sisters <u>TODAY</u> we did learn some<u>LESSONS ON PRAYER</u> from the Lord Himself and from
